

Can you apply for a travel pass for foreign nationals?

This questionnaire is not an application form. <u>It must not be sent to the FPS Foreign Affairs</u>.

This questionnaire is just a tool to help you find out if you meet the **conditions** and **which documents** you require in order to apply for a travel pass for foreign nationals.

Even if you answer yes to 3 questions, your application is admissible but **it does not ensure you a positive response** from the FPS Foreign Affairs.

In this case, you can apply for an approval of issuance of a travel pass for foreign nationals by e-mail to passeport@diplobel.fed.be (with the subject: "Application for a travel pass for foreign nationals") or by letter (FPS Foreign Affairs, Travel and Identity Documents Directorate, Service C2.2 Individual Dossiers & National Regulation, rue des Petits Carmes 15, 1000 Brussels) with the following information:

- Your last name and first names
- Your place of birth
- Your nationality
- A copy of your residence permit
- A copy of any other documents concerning your situation.

In the case of an application for a minor, the parents or guardian submit the application.

Attention:

- Even if you meet the above mentioned basic conditions, there is **no guarantee of receiving an** issuance **agreement**.
- Several additional verifications will be carried out, including your criminal record, which may take up to 6 weeks. You will receive the **final decision within maximum 6 weeks**.
- If the decision is positive, your municipality will be informed, and you will have to present yourself there **within 2 weeks** in order to register your application for a travel document for foreigners.
